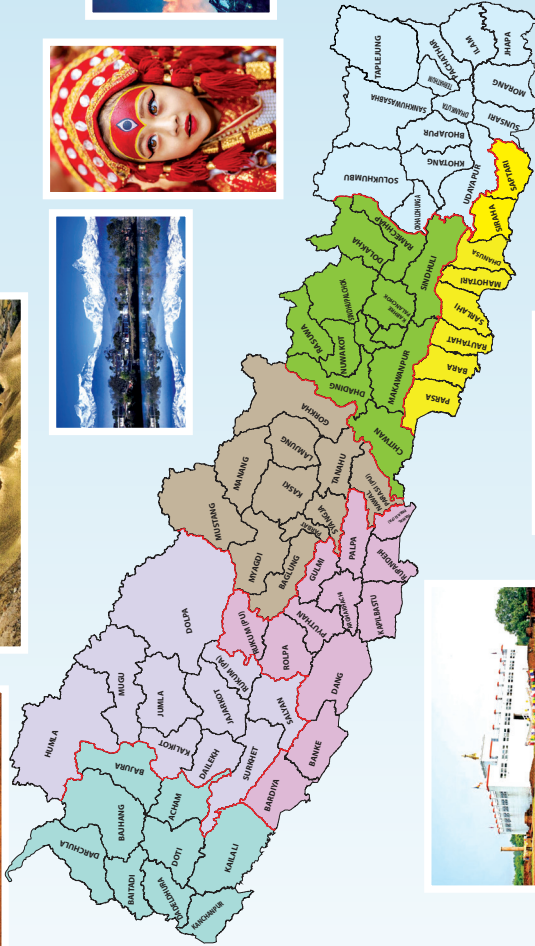

TOURIST ARRIVALS



The tourism sector is recovering at a fast pace with decline of the Covid-19 pandemic worldwide. As a result, the number of tourists arrivals Nepal in 2022 increased by 307% (reaching 614,869) compared to the previous year. Major country of tourist arrivals in 2022 was a bit different compared to previous year. The top five countries from which tourist arrived were India (34.05%), USA (12.54%), U.K. (7.33%), Australia (4.37%), and Bangladesh (4.13%), respectively. Among the total number of international arrivals, 592,631 (96.4%) arrived by air, while 22,238 (3.6%) arrived by land.

CHART 2.1: TOURIST ARRIVAL IN NEPAL 2013-2022

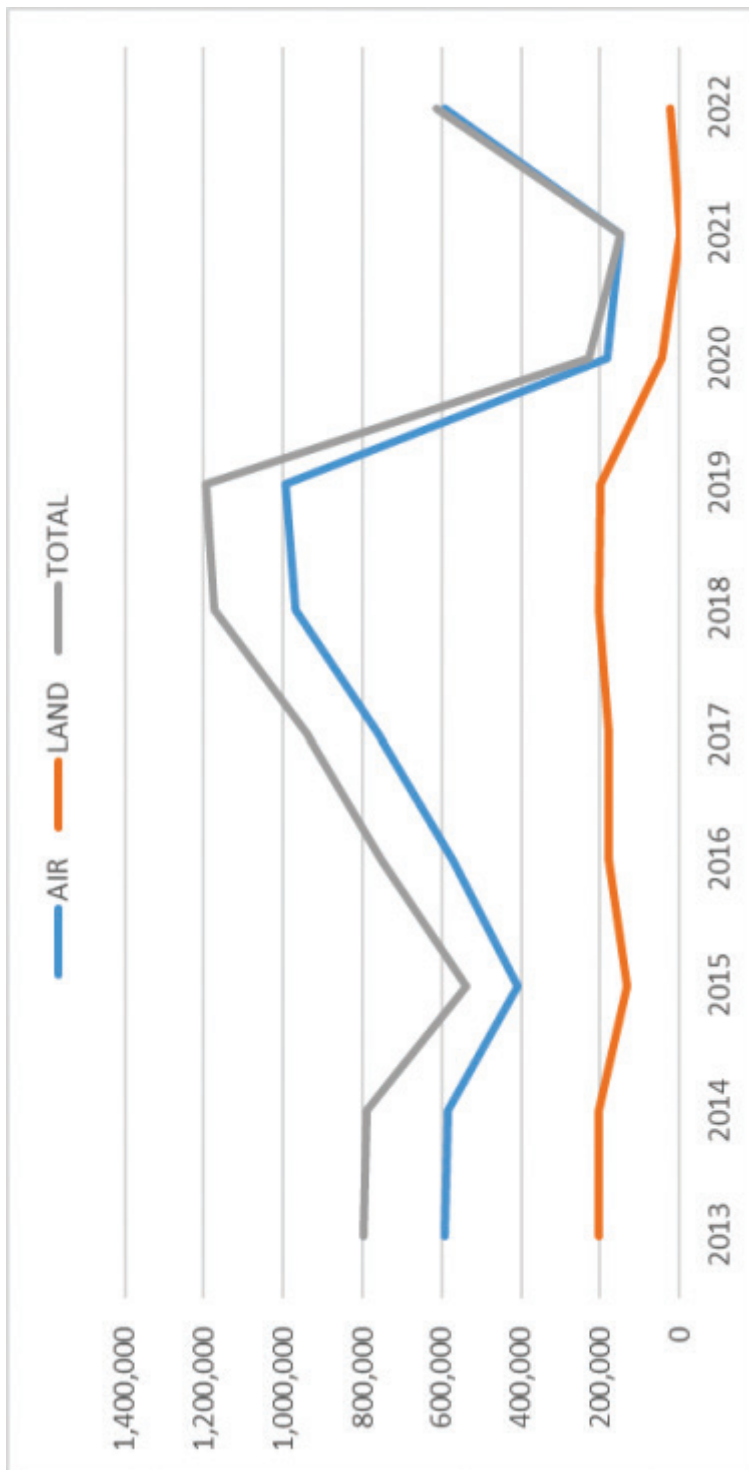

CHART 2.2: TOURIST ARRIVAL BY MONTH, 2018-2022

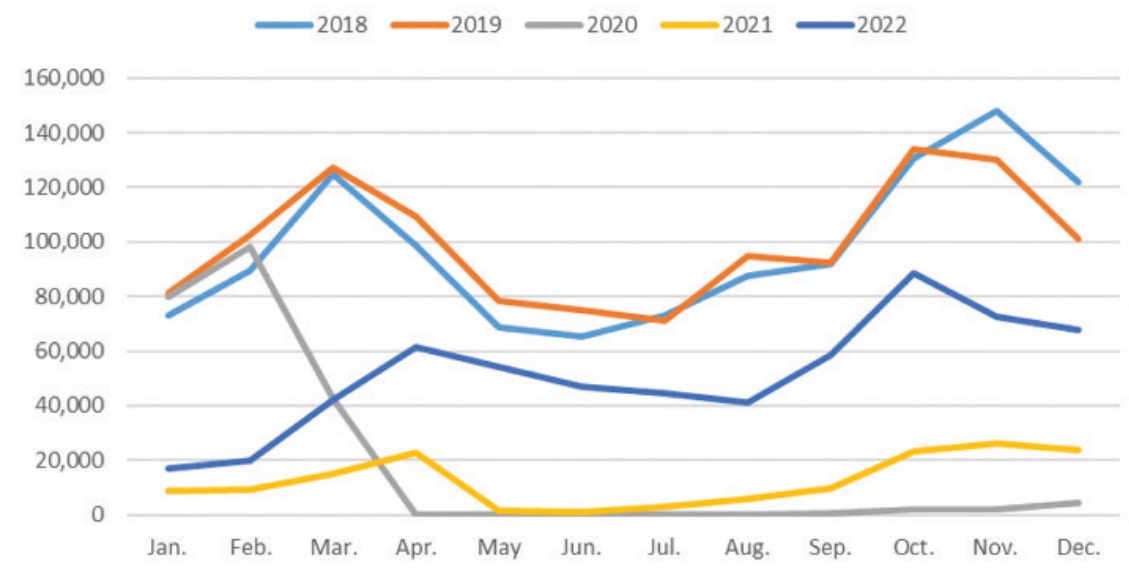

CHART: 2.3 TOURIST ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY, 2018-2022

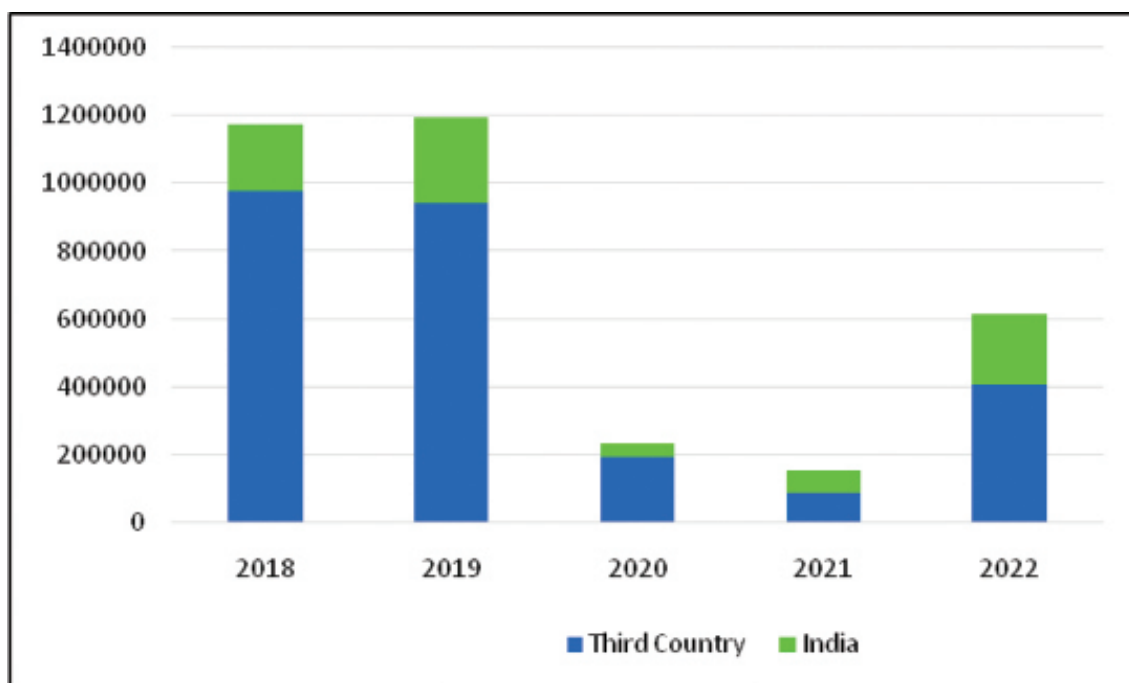

CHART 2.4: TOURIST ARRIVAL BY SEX, 2018-2022

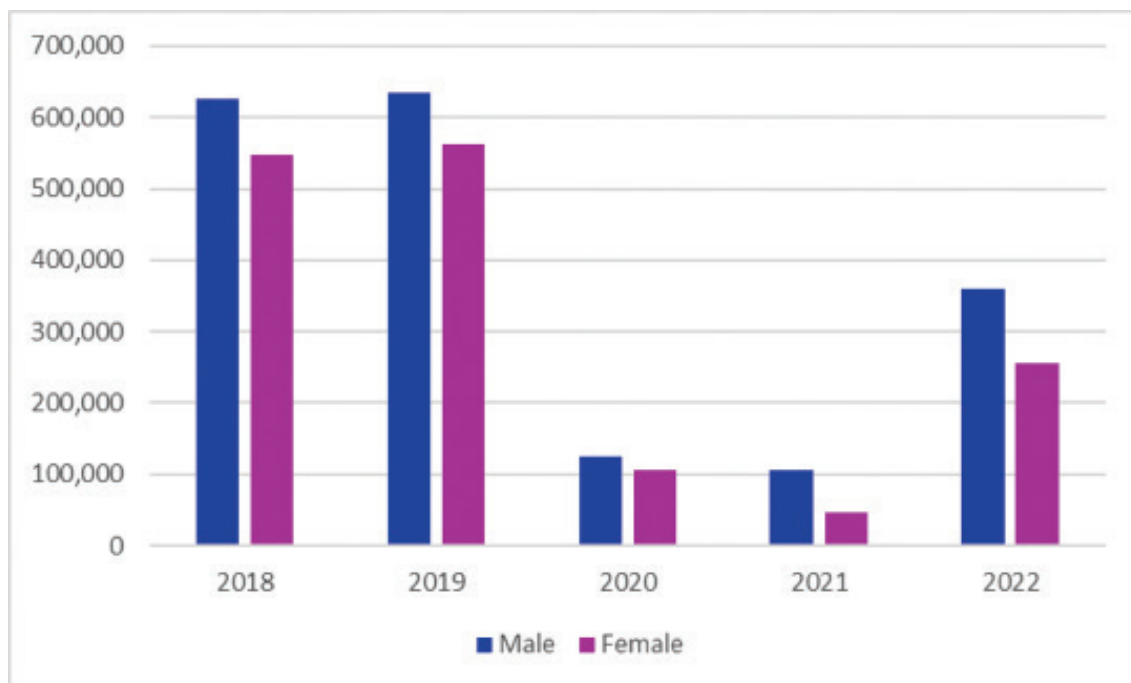

CHART 2.5: TOURIST ARRIVALS BY AGE GROUP, 2018-2022

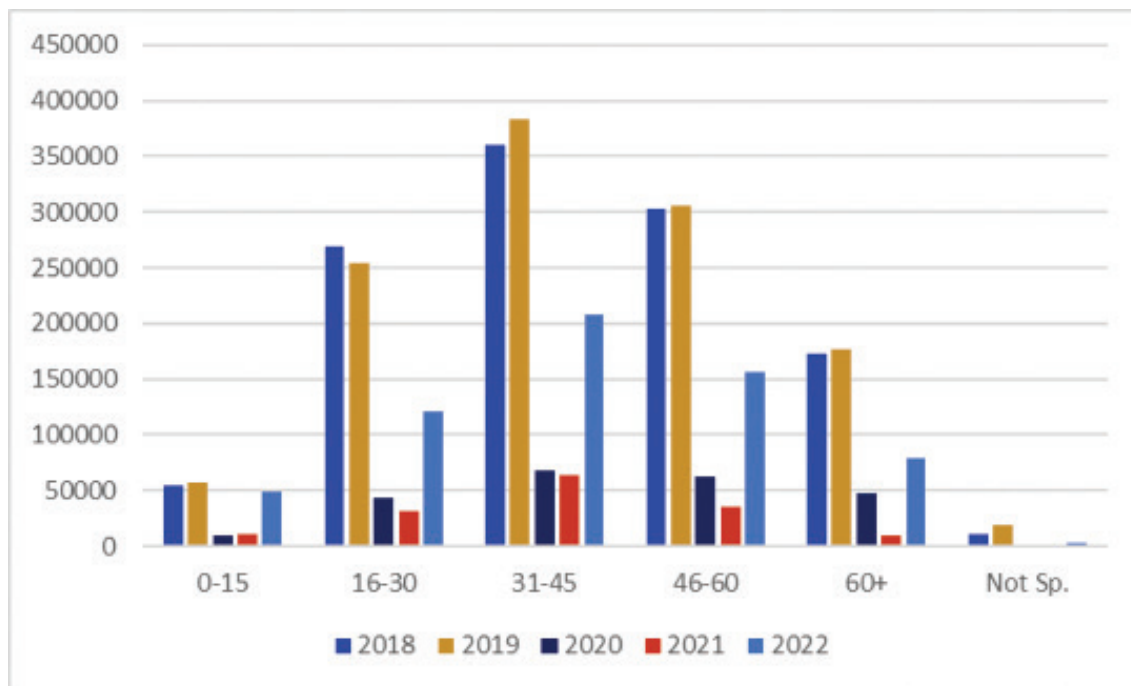

LENGTH OF STAY

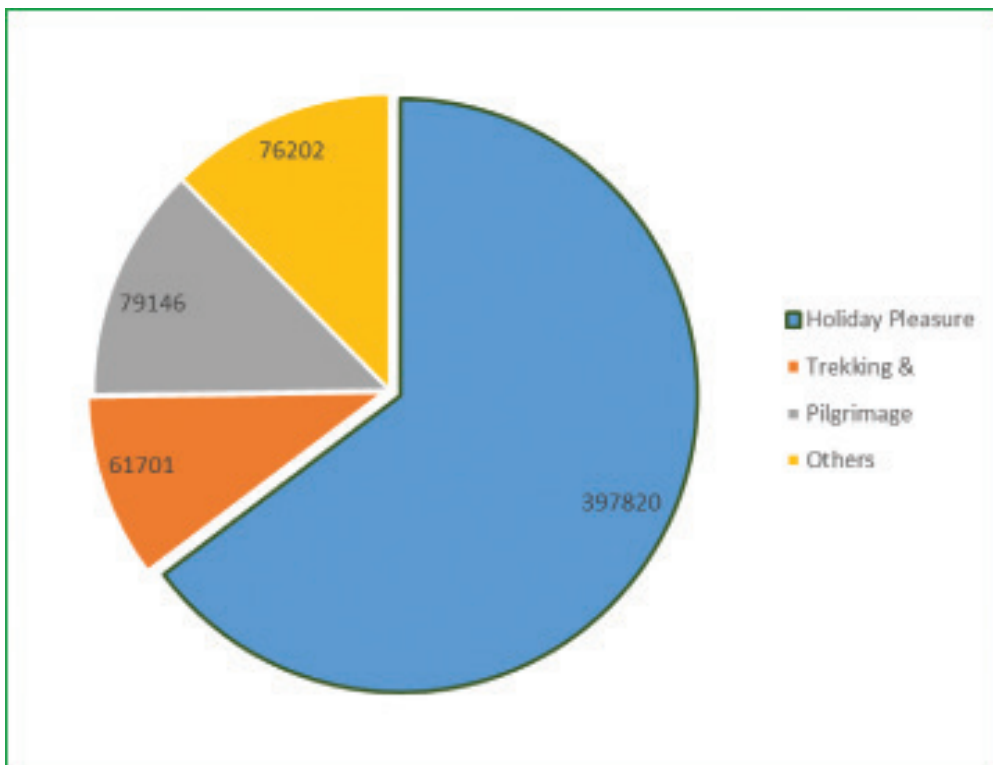

Nepal is renowned for adventure tourism due to its prominent peaks. The number of expedition permitted teams reached 1952(156%) increased in 2022 compare to the previous year. Mainly climbers came from USA, UK, France, Spain, India and Germany respectively. The Mt. Everest, Mt. Aamadablam and Mt. Manaslu are most likes mountain for expedition. Out of 614869 tourists 53,233 tourists trekked at different part of Nepal.

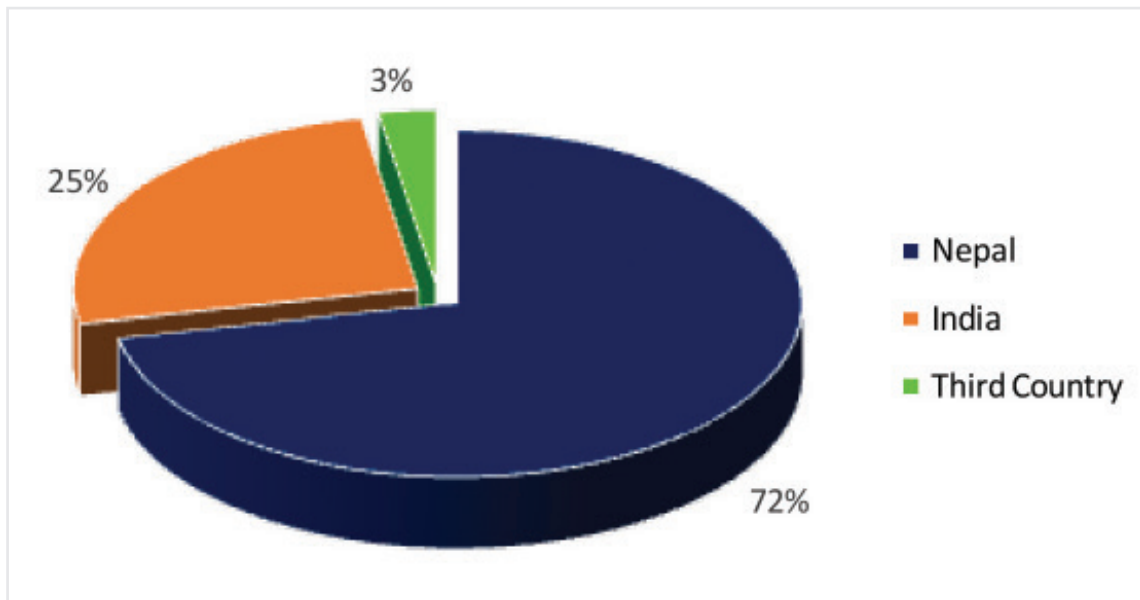

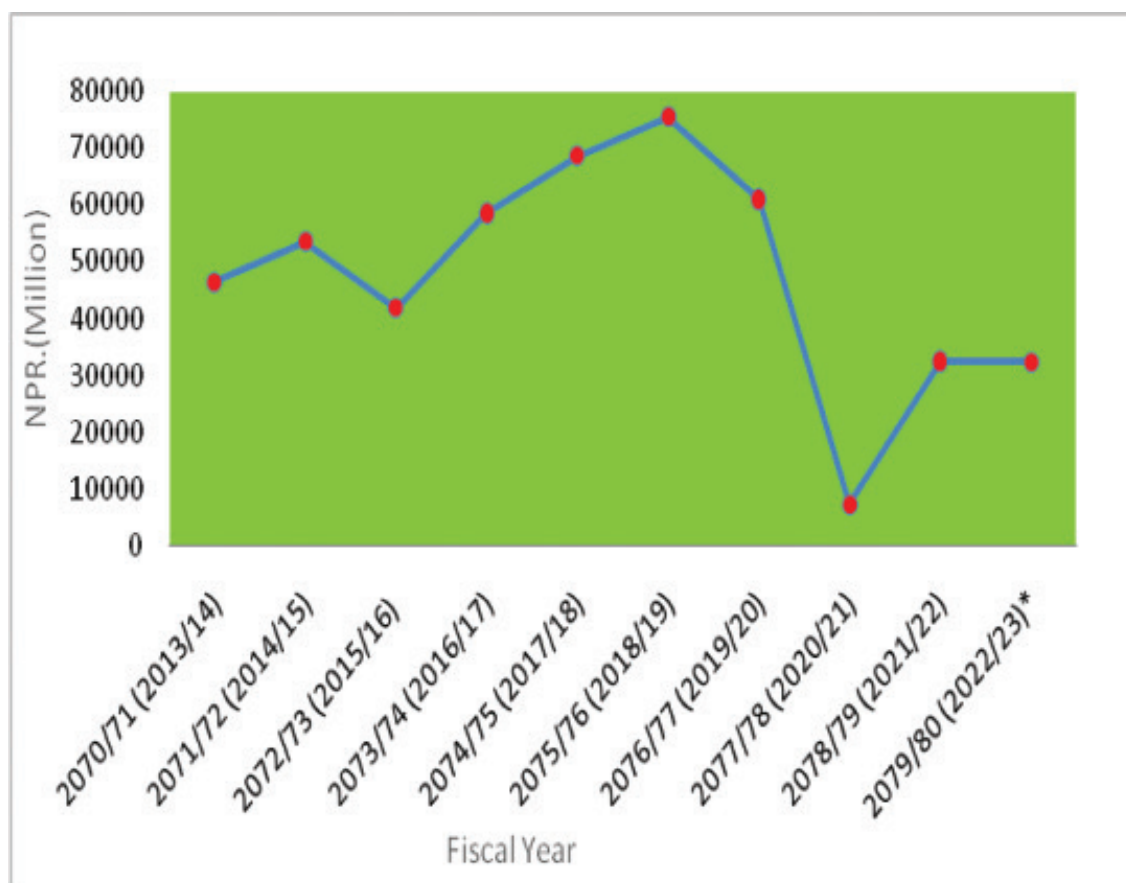

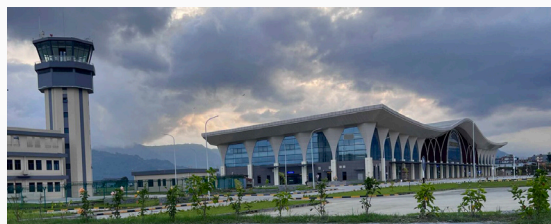

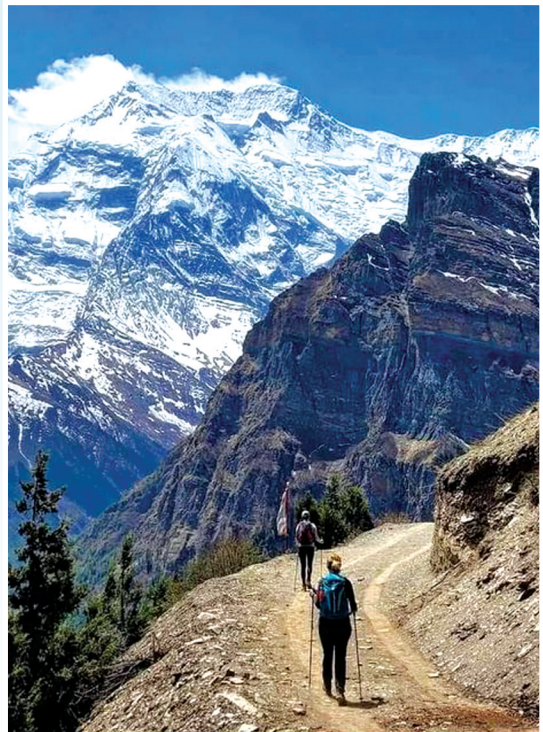
