




TOURIST ARRIVALS



Tourism sector in worldwide severely affected by Covid 19. As a result tourist arrivals in Nepal in 2021 was almost 34.3% (150962) less than previous year. Scenario of tourist arrivals was almost different from previous year. The major five countries are; India (42.8%), USA (15.13%), U.K. (5.7%), China (4.1%), Bangladesh (3.3%), respectively. Of the total international arrivals 150,625(99.7%) arrived by air and 337 (0.3%) arrived by road.

CHART 2.1: TOURIST ARRIVAL IN NEPAL 2012-2021



CHART 2.2: TOURIST ARRIVAL BY MONTH, 2017-2021



CHART: 2.3 TOURIST ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY, 2017-2021



CHART 2.4 : TOURIST ARRIVAL BY SEX, 2017-2021



CHART 2.5 : TOURIST ARRIVAL BY AGE GROUP, 2017-2021





Lumbini, being birth place of Lord Buddha and Pashupatinath, a centre of faith for Hinduism is major among many important places. Lumbini is found as most visited pilgrimage by foreigners. It was visited by 508,892 persons out of them 91.1% were Nepalese while 8.6% Indians and 0.23% from other countries in the year 2021. Similarly, the 3,190 visitors from third country visited the Pashupatinath during the year 2021.




Tourism sector earnings directly correlated with tourist arrivals. Due to Covid 19 tourist arrivals in 2021 decreased by 34.3 percent, earning from tourism sectors also decreased by almost 46 percent in compare to last year. In 2021, gross foreign exchange earning was Nrs.13,501,100 thousand, (Around 112,509 thousand US\$). As decrease in total gross foreign earning, Per day expenditure also decreased to 48 USD per tourist per day in 2021.


